A. ADVERTISEMENT AND NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Sealed bids will be received by the City Clerk of the City of Peekskill until 11:00 AM at the prevailing time on April 23, 2015 at City Hall, 840 Main Street, Peekskill, New York 10566, for Bid Number 2015-002 – Nelson Avenue Parking Garage Project. Work consists of metal deck repairs, fireproofing, steel beam repairs, concrete repairs and water proofing at the Nelson Avenue Parking Garage located at 900 Central Avenue, Peekskill, New York 10566.

Copies of the Bid Documents are on file and may be obtained at the Department of City Services, City Hall, 840 Main Street, Peekskill, New York 10566. These documents may be obtained for a non-refundable fee of One-Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

Bid sets will be mailed upon receipt of the deposit and the bidder's FEDEX delivery service account number.

A mandatory Pre-Bid Meeting will be held at City Hall on April 9, 2015 at 10:00 a.m. with representatives of the City present to discuss the Bid Requirements and to address questions from bidders. After the meeting, the Engineer and Water Department personnel will conduct a tour of the site.

As a bid security, each proposal shall be accompanied by a certified check or bid bond in the amount of five percent (5%) of the total amount of the total bid. The bidder to whom a bid is awarded will be required to furnish performance and payment bonds from an acceptable surety company in the form included in the Bidding Documents in the total amount of the bid.


The right is reserved to reject any or all bids.

Attention of all bidders is directed to the Labor Law Requirement that Public Work Contractors and Subcontractors pay Laborers, Workers, or Mechanics employed in the performance of a Public Work Contract not less than the Prevailing Rate of Wage and Supplements (Fringe Benefits) in the locality where the work is performed.

The Wages and Supplements to be paid and/or provided to Laborers, Workers and Mechanics employed on a Public Work Project shall not be less than those listed in the Current Prevailing Rate Schedule for the locality where the work is performed. The Prevailing Rate Schedules are included in the Bid Documents.
