ANY COMMENTS MUST BE MADE ALOUD DURING THE PUBLIC COMMENT SECTION OF THE MEETING. IF YOU USE THE CHAT ROOM TO CONVERSE, YOU WILL BE REMOVED FROM THE MEETING.

Only one person can speak at a time. No foul language is to be used. If there are any flyers citizens wish to share, they must be sent to the City Manager or Deputy City Clerk prior to the meeting and they can screen share these items as long as they are sent in advance.

**RESOLUTION DESIGNATING OFFICIAL BANKS FOR THE CITY OF PEEKSKILL
FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2023**

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 3-b of the General City Law of the State of New York, Section 10 of the General Municipal Law (GML) of the State of New York and Sections C55 and C58 of the Charter of the City of Peekskill, the City must designate one or more banks for the deposit of public funds; and

WHEREAS, the City is hereby designating Wells Fargo, JP Morgan Chase, Orange Bank and Trust Company, PCS Bank, Signature Bank, Sterling National Bank, TD Bank, M&T Bank, People's United Bank, and New York Liquid Asset Fund as banking institutions and/or depositories for the City of Peekskill and that all funds and monies of the City of Peekskill be deposited to the credit of the City of Peekskill in said banking institutions and/or depositories for the year 2023; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 10 of the GML, shall specify the maximum amount which may be kept on deposit at any time in each bank or trust company; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 10 of the GML, the City has determined that Twenty Five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000) shall be the maximum amount the Comptroller may maintain in deposits at each bank.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that the City Manager, Comptroller and all other officers of the City of Peekskill into whose hands come monies or funds belonging to the City of Peekskill be, and they are hereby directed to deposit said funds and monies to the credit of the City of Peekskill with the following banking institutions and/or depositories: Wells Fargo, JP Morgan Chase, Orange Bank and Trust Company, PCS Bank, Signature Bank, Sterling National Bank, TD Bank, M&T Bank, People's United Bank, and New York Liquid Asset Fund; and be it further

RESOLVED, that the City Manager, Comptroller and the Common Council take such bond and/or bonds, certificates or notes of the United States of America, State of New York, New York Municipalities or School Districts as security for the funds deposited in each banking institution in such amounts and in a form as the Comptroller shall recommend in writing to the Common Council, subject to the approval of the Common Council, and the Common Council

hereby reserves the right to fix said amounts in sums other than recommended by the Comptroller;
and be it further

RESOLVED, that Twenty Five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000) shall be the maximum
amount the Comptroller may maintain in deposits at each bank

RESOLUTION DESIGNATING THE OFFICIAL AND SUPPLEMENTAL NEWSPAPERS

WHEREAS, pursuant to §C40 of the Peekskill City Charter, annually, in the month of January, the Common Council shall designate one or more newspapers circulated in the City as the official newspapers.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT

RESOLVED, that pursuant to §C40 of the City Charter, as amended, the Journal News is hereby designated as the official newspaper of the City of Peekskill, and the Westchester Hispano is designated as a supplemental newspaper of the City of Peekskill, in which shall be published, at such times and in such alternate manner as shall be determined by the City, all legal notices required to be published, except as otherwise provided by the Local Finance law, for the calendar year 2023.
